- 6** Be respected and not be excluded
- 7** Have privacy in virtual environments
- 8** Express ourselves freely and be heard
- 9** Learn, play and have fun just like everyone else
- 10** Have the assistive products we need (subtitling, induction loop, FM systems, interpreter for sign language users, etc.)
