WE HAVE THE RIGHT TO...

- 1 To be cared for and protected in health matters
- 2 To learn like other children
- 3 To play whatever we like
- 4 To enjoy leisure and culture
- 5 To have equal access to the internet and social media
- 6 To take part in decisions that involve us
- 7 To speak out freely
- 8 To feel capable. To be independent

THAT'S WHY WE DEMAND...

- 1 Hearing accessibility to information and communication to be able to take part in any environment (education, culture, leisure, etc.)
- 2 Assistive listening and oral communication products (subtitling, induction loop, etc.), specialised teachers and sign language interpreters for deaf people who communicate in sign language
- 3 Audiovisual materials and platforms with subtitling and sign language interpretation
- 4 Warnings or alarms with sound and light signals
- 5 A social perception adapted to the current reality of deaf children and adolescents away from stereotypes
