- To have equal access to the internet and social media
- To take part in decisions that involve us
- To speak out freely
- To feel capable. To be independent

THAT'S WHY WE DEMAND...

- Hearing accessibility to information and communication to be able to take part in any environment (education, culture, leisure, etc.)
- Assistive listening and oral communication products (subtitling, induction loop, etc.), specialised teachers and sign language interpreters for deaf people who communicate in sign language
- Audiovisual materials and platforms with subtitling and sign language interpretation
- Warnings or alarms with sound and light signals
- A social perception adapted to the current reality of deaf children and adolescents away from stereotypes
