GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS WITH HEARING DISABILITIES ON THEIR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE DIGITAL ENVIRONMENT AND SOCIAL MEDIA



- 1. We have the right to access information through technology
- 2. We want to enjoy our leisure time and our relationship with friends and peers on the internet
 - 3. Our families must educate us in the use of technology and, in turn, be trained to do so
 - 4. We do not want to access violent or age-inappropriate content
 - 5. We must reflect on whether the content we publish on the internet is appropriate
 - 6. We must be careful with our privacy by limiting personal information and using strong passwords
 - 7. We must never share or participate in images or comments that harm other people
 - 8. Zero tolerance for rejection or cyberbulling. Tomorrow it could be you
- 9. If I am upset by content on the internet, I can ask for help from my family, my school or my association
 - 10. In the event of cyberbullying or any doubts about it, there are channels to consult and report it
